




7. Your course will appear in a new window.

Note: If your course does not launch, you may need to disable pop up blockers




8. Select the **in LEARNING** in the top left corner




9. If logging in for the first time, you will be asked to complete your account set up.
Click **“Sounds good”**




10. Select topics that you are interested in learning and select **“Continue”**
